"He told them this parable: "No one tears a piece out of a new garment to patch an old one. Otherwise, they will have torn the new garment, and the patch from the new will not match the old. And no one pours new wine into old wineskins. Otherwise, the new wine will burst the skins; the wine will run out and the wineskins will be ruined. No, new wine must be poured into new wineskins." ~ Luke 5:36-38

I know very little about "sewing" patches on fabric—do they still do that these days? I know even less about "wine making"—especially how it was made thousands of years ago. Still, Jesus' illustrations make sense to me. I can see how that sowing a new patch on an old garment will draw up the surrounding material when it shrinks and make it look all crinkly. I can see how that the gasses produced by fermentation will cause old wineskins to burst because they've already been stretched to their capacity.

But I also know that Jesus isn't really talking about sewing or wine making. He's talking about "DISPENSATION"—the ensuing end of the Mosaic Dispensation and the inauguration of a new Christian Dispensation. He's talking about "COVENANT"—and how the New Covenant in Christ is not like the Old Covenant with its Law of Moses. He's talking about "KINGDOM" and how new Messianic Kingdom culture, and new ways of thinking about our relationship with God, will supplant old Davidic Kingdom culture and old, traditional, Levitical thinking in regard to our relationship with God.

Jesus finished this little teachable moment with these words... "no one after drinking old wine wants the new, for they say, 'The old is better" – (Luke 5:39). Sadly, many people of Jesus' day, and many still today, reject TRUTH in favor of maintaining their COMFORT zones. They like what they've got-the status quo-and don't want change. They're comfortable with the doctrines and traditions they've grown up with, or have been taught in the past, and don't want to be challenged. Whatever knowledge they possess is enough for them, and they don't want to grow. I hope that's not the case with you and me, beloved... because the New Covenant in Christ, with all its accompanying promises from God, is just too beautiful to miss.

Lord, give us new eyes to see the truths You've revealed to us ~ Phil
