It was no different for Mrs. Zebedee — the mother of two of Jesus’ disciples, James and John. Expecting an “earthly” kingdom, she was all wrapped up in this world and the things of this world.

I must confess that I’m too much like her. While not so concerned anymore with how people may view me, still, I do like to brag on my kids, and I want people to think as highly of them as I do. The problem is that this attitude can sometimes send all the wrong signals both to my kiddos and to others. I, they, and everyone else can kinda get to thinking that power, position, and success in this world is what I think life is really all about. But looking over Jesus’ words in the passage above, it just isn’t, is it?

So, I might want to stop and ask myself, “What do I most want for my children?” and “How do I really want people to perceive them?” Do I want them to be seen as beautiful servants of the Lord and others, or envied and feared as prestigious and powerful little taskmasters?
