"You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; it is these that testify about Me; and you are unwilling to come to Me so that you may have life" ... "How can you believe, when you receive glory from one another, and you do not seek the glory that is from the one and only God?"

~ John 5:39-40 & 44

It amazes me, sometimes, at just how dependent we are on the approval of men. Of course, as God's children, we seek to follow the Apostle Paul's admonition and example when he said. "we have regard for what is honorable, not only in the sight of the Lord, but also in the sight of men" (2 Corinthians 8:21). But I think that's a far cry from wanting to impress people and gain recognition in the eyes of men. In the passage above, Jesus points out that the religious leaders in Israel were so busy trying to impress one another, and gain recognition and approval from one another, that they simply could not allow themselves to give honest consideration to Jesus; even though the scriptures testified of Him—their long-awaited Messiah Who was standing right in front them. In the midst of that discourse with them, He said, "I know you, that you do not have the love of God in yourselves" (John 5:42).

This has me wondering... when Jesus looks into my heart and yours, does He see people seeking to please other people and gain the approval of one another; or people seeking to honor and please Him? Does He see people protecting and promoting their cherished religious doctrines and traditions; or people sincerely interested in seeking an authentic, personal relationship with Him? Does He see us coming to the holy scriptures looking for ammunition to help prove our already predetermined personal viewpoints; or students of the Word sincerely wanting to grow in our knowledge and understanding of Him and His will for our lives?

If other people in the church or in the community think well of us, that's a good thing, I guess. But, ultimately, it's completely irrelevant in light of what Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior thinks of us when He looks into our hearts, isn't it?




