
~ (John 6:66-69)

Jesus said many things that challenged Jewish tradition and upset the religious leaders. But isn't it interesting that, as we learn from this passage, even many of His own disciples got upset at His teaching and abandoned Him. So dramatic was this incredible falling away that Jesus even turned to His closest disciples—the apostles themselves—and asked if they, too, wanted to desert Him.

I guess, then, that we should not be so surprised when we see people who once proclaimed a faith in Christ turn away from truth and simply stop following Him. We might even ask, “were they ever really His disciple to begin with?” And while it is not up to us to sit in judgment of such matters, the fact is that, while some were, many weren't.

It is quite easy for people to put up a pretense and act like they are just all about Jesus. They may even get all emotional about their faith and make bold declarations of love and loyalty to Christ. But their self-declared claim to faith only lasts for as long as everything seems to be going their way and they personally approve of what is taught. When the truth of God's word runs counter to their chosen lifestyle, or their personal desires, beliefs, or traditions... they're gone!

May we, like Peter, realize that, while a lot of what Jesus taught is incredibly challenging, still, only He has the words of eternal life! ~ Phil
