-Chief ruler of the people

-Oversee priest and their duties

-Other duties (Ex. 25:30; 27:20,21; Lev. 6:14,15; 13:2-59; Deut. 17:12)

-Carried breastplate with tribes names, mediator, & Urim and Thummin divination

-Day of Atonement duties (Leviticus 16)

REQUIREMENTS FOR A HIGH PRIEST	REASON FOR QUALIFICATION	REALITY OF JESUS	RESULT FOR US
Call from among the people (5:1)	To be the people's intercessor in offering sacrifices to God	A man (5:7a)	Jesus can be our Mediator (see 1 Tim. 2:5)
Compassion for the people (5:2)	To <i>feel</i> with the people in order to represent them before God	A sympathetic High Priest (5:7-10)	Jesus <i>feels</i> with us (see Heb. 4:14-16)
Commission <i>not</i> from the people (5:4)	To be God-approved to do the job	Divinely appointed (5:5, 6)	Jesus' sacrifice is accepted; salvation is extended to all who obey Him
