*And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit was giving them utterance. Now there were Jews living in Jerusalem, devout men from every nation under heaven. And when this sound occurred, the crowd came together and were bewildered because each one of them was hearing them speak in his own language... And they all continued in amazement and great perplexity, saying to one another, "What does this mean?" But others were mocking and saying, "They are full of sweet wine."*  
~ (Matthew 2:4-12)

I stand amazed at the empowering of the Holy Spirit as He worked in and through the apostles and prophets of the first century. When the Holy Spirit empowered them with the gift of "tongues" [γλώσσαις – glōssais: "language"], they were able to speak various known languages fluently without ever having studied or learned those languages. So perfectly were they speaking these different languages, that the people listening heard them in their own [ιδία διαλέκτω - *idia dialektō*: distinct dialect] — the specific native dialect to which they were born and raised.

Wow! What a large-scale public spectacle; a miracle witnessed by literally thousands. I have to confess that there are days when I wish that I, or maybe one of you, could be blessed with the opportunity to perform such a grand miracle in today's world; just so we could get people's attention and convince them of their need for the message of the gospel that we are trying to share with them.

But then I read those last few lines from the passage above where the Bible tells us that, "others were mocking and saying, "They are full of sweet wine." Oh my! Not only did many choose not to believe the miracle, they even went so far as to make fun of the disciples and accuse them of being drunk! So, it appears as if, miracles notwithstanding, people are going to hear what they want to hear, believe what they want to believe, and choose to live however they want to live.

I learn from this that, while such miracles certainly confirmed the word of God and helped bring the Lord's church into existence back in the 1<sup>st</sup> century, we don't need to rely on miracles to convince anybody of the gospel message today. All we really need to do is simply "speak the truth in love" (Ephesians 4:15). Those with good and honest hearts will hear and believe...


