"Mary was seated at the Lord's feet, listening to His word. Martha was distracted with all her preparations; and she came up to Him and said, "Lord, do You not care that my sister has left me to do all the serving alone? Then tell her to help me." But the Lord answered and said to her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and bothered about so many things; but only one thing is necessary, for Mary has chosen the good part, which shall not be taken away from her." "

~ (Luke 10:39-42)

I read the passage above and feel compelled to want to criticize Martha... but then, I think to myself, "Wait, I'm just like her!" I am just *soooo* busy, aren't you? In fact, it's almost become a source of pride among us as to how busy we are. We even seem to go looking for more and more things with which to crowd our lives and keep us busy. We tend to run ourselves ragged, and even run our children ragged, with all kinds of "good things" that add to the business of our lives.

It even gets to the point where—let's just come on out and say it—we're too busy with all the obligations of this world—all the commitments, deadlines, and appointments—to be overly concerned with the spiritual stuff. I mean, Jesus can wait, but all these other things to which I've committed myself aren't gonna wait, right?

But Mary didn't think Jesus could wait, did she? Even though there was plenty of "stuff" to do, she made the decision to seat herself at Jesus' feet, listening, hanging on to His every word.

I love Jesus' use of the word, "necessary," in this text. Like me, Martha was worried and bothered about so many things. But only one thing is really "necessary"... sitting at the feet of Jesus and learning from Him. So, I'm thinking this may be a good time for me, and maybe for you, to take inventory of our lives and to, maybe, prioritize what is really important! $\sim Phil$


